What to expect

When attending our Day Centres, you will spend the day enjoying a variety of wellbeing activities of your choice, all while being supported by our qualified team of home care staff and nurses in one of our secure, purpose-built centres.

We provide morning tea and hot lunch, optional attendance for short outings in the community, and the celebration of special events throughout the year.

Our Day Centres can provide the following services through CHSP funding:

Social Support Group – participate in a variety of creative and therapeutic activities including gardening, cooking, crafts, and reminiscence activities.

Attend local venues and join in local entertainment. Celebrate as a group for local, national and international events, as well as personal milestones.

Centre Based Respite – spend the day participating in all the centre activities available, while offering your family or carer the opportunity to rejuvenate for the day.

Transport – our day centre staff can provide transport to and from the day centre to your home in our accessible buses.

Allied Health and Therapy Services – both centres are supported by our Anglican Care Allied Health team providing the opportunity to maintain and restore your physical abilities.

Meal preparation – participate in programs devised by accredited dietitians to assist with preparing and cooking nutritional meals.



How to access this service

To access this service, you will first need CHSP funding, available through the Australian Government, My Aged Care on 1800 200 422 or visit their website to arrange an aged care assessment.

Our programs support all seniors living in the community, inclusive of seniors with memory loss and dementia, with our diversional therapist, dementia care lead, and activity officers creating an all-inclusive day of activities. We provide strategies and support to participants, their families, and carers through our onsite information meetings.

Each program has an out-of-pocket fee depending on the type and number of services required. Our friendly team will discuss fees with you prior to your commencement.

We provide a tour of our centres prior to commencement, including discussions with our intake team. You may also be offered a trial day before commencing the service.
