As a result of the recent update by NSW Health, we are delighted to recommence limited visitation at Warnervale Gardens from next Tuesday, 29<sup>th</sup> September, 2020. Further correspondence will be provided to the consumers, families and friends at Warnervale Gardens.

The Public Health (COVID-19 Aged Care Facilities) Order has been renewed by the NSW state government. This order was initially issued in May & outlines the requirements for Residential Aged Care facilities during the COVID-19 period. The renewed order has continued the requirement for up to date influenza vaccinations for anyone entering a residential aged care facility. This new order has been extended until 17<sup>th</sup> December, 2020.

We will continue to monitor and review our visitation needs across our services. While there are limited in-person visitation bookings, I would encourage everyone to continue to utilize zoom video and voice calls to remain connected with your loved one.
