Please note: the prices above are subject to change and shall vary in accordance with the Maximum Permissible Interest Rate (MPIR) as determined by the Department of Social Services on a quarterly basis.

Pricing options

or

Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD)

A lump sum payment made to the aged care home that is fully refunded to you or your estate when you leave the home. or _____

Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP)

This payment is not refundable. Some people may prefer to pay for their accommodation based on a daily rate.

A combination of RAD and DAP

If you decide to make a combined RAD and DAP payment, the DAP amount will be adjusted based on the lump sum amount paid.

Below is an example of a combined RAD and DAP payment based on a RAD of \$550,000. In this example the resident has \$275,000 available for part payment of the RAD. This means the DAP is worked out on the remaining \$275,000 using an MPIR of 8.15%. DAP = $$275,000 \times 8.15\% \div 365$ DAP = \$61.40

So instead of paying the full RAD of \$550,000 the resident would pay a part RAD of \$275,00 as well as a DAP of \$61.40
